### **Information Sharing**

- In the month of February, the Residents responded on **25** calls in 136, **5** calls in 166, and **0** calls in 146.
- Recent In District Wildland/Vegetation/Smoke Investigation Events:

- Other significant Calls:
  - February 8, 136 and 166 responded with 9 personnel to a house fire at 2655 NW Highland Dr
  - February 25, 136 responded with 5 to an MVA on Lester Ave.
- In the last month, the Residents worked **1,642** Shift Hours.

### **February/March Fire Prevention Activities**

- Backyard Burning is in effect as of March 1. We are updating the Burn Line daily.
- No Commercial Inspections.
- Residential WUI/Wildfire Property Risk Assessments this past month: None requested since late February.

### **February Station Out of Service Report**

- 2/10/2022 from 1940 to 2200.
- 2.3 hours out of service.
- In Service 99.6%.

### **Current Level of Staffing as of March 16, 2022**

- Residents: 11
- Community Volunteers: 0
- Currently, we have 4 Crew Leaders, 5 Apparatus Operators, and 2 AO Trainees. Additionally, 6 are Tender operators.
- 5 of the RRVs/RCVs are state licensed EMTs. The other 6 are in process. They have all completed the class portion of EMT School.
- Hoover and Kruckewitt completed the AO Program.
- Timm recently completed the Tender Operator Training Program.
- Staff anticipates numerous vacancies being created through 2022 as a result of regional hiring. Many of the RRVs have applied to the current CFD Firefighter Job Opening.

### **Training**

- RRVs participated recent trainings that have included the annual wildland firefighter refresher, vehicle extrication, nurse and shuttle tender operations, and patient interviewing skills.

### **Projects Update**

- **Flooring:** Rubenstein's to contact LT with install plan, and LT will coordinate the moving of furniture etc...contacted by Randy last week....they are committed to other projects currently.
- **Annual CRFPD Inventory:** All CRFPD rigs have been inventoried. Crew is in the process of acquiring missing items.
- Met with Tony on site for **HVAC install walk through** with Pace. The pad area for the heat pumps outside the laundry room (south exterior wall, living side) were prepped. Four boxwoods were dug out and removed, irrigation line was redirected, area was leveled.
- Thermador Cooktop Repairs: we have ordered new igniters and will install once we receive all the parts.
- **Station Inspection** was completed with Loomis and Conder. Crew has completed the checklist.
