




CRFPD CALL COUNTS BY DAY OF MONTH




CFD CALL COUNT BY FIRE DISTRICT CALL OCCURRED IN

STATION 6 LT REPORT

New Business:

- All New RRV's are operational and responding on calls.
- We have had 2 RRV's obtain Crew Leader and 3 obtain Apparatus Operator over the past 2 months. This along with all new RRV's becoming operational will greatly impact or in-service time on 136.
- Apex completed hood cleaning. Access to cleanouts in attic space are difficult to reach, we will be adding in some 2x4 pieces to better access them.
- Insulation was added to the propane gas line that supplies the generator. This was a request from NW Mechanical after the pressure alarm continued to activate from summer heat reflecting off the metal panels.
- Christmas lights were inventoried to be installed this year and were found to be in bad shape. They were not installed last year due to the lack of working lights. New lights were purchased and installed by RRV's.

- Painting in kitchen and men’s bathroom was completed this week.
- Drains in parking lot have been working well. Crews are attempting to keep all drains clear of debris during this season with leaves falling.
- Crews have spent hours on cleaning up the landscaping and getting it to a more appealing state while we wait for the contractors to come complete the overhaul work.
- Coffee maker stopped working and was deemed unrepairable. Ordered replacement to match previous coffee maker.
